



How to add “DeviceID” Field in the Assets window.


1. Right-click the topmost row of the “Assets” window.




2. Select/Click “Add Extra Cols...”. The “Extra cols” window will pop-up.




3. Right click inside “Extra cols” window and select/click “Add extended asset property...”
Another menu window will pop-up.




4. Under the “Type” drop down box, select “Device”




5. Under the “Property” drop down box, select “DeviceID”



6. Click “Ok” to close the menu window.



- Click “Ok” to close “Extra cols” window.



New “DeviceID” Field will be added at the right most column of the “Assets” window.


Note: As required, you may need to slide the “Assets” window bottom bar to the right in order to able to see this added field. Unfortunately, IPS does not allow yet re-arrangement of the column fields, however, it allows them to be hidden.


You can add other fields using the above procedure. Simply select any other fields available from the drop down menu in Step 4 and Step 5.

How to Hide Insignificant Fields in “Assets” Window:

1. Right-click the topmost row of the “Assets” window.



2. Tick/untick the field that is relevant to your work.




Note: Unfortunately, IPS only allows 1 field at a time. In order to do more fields, repeat steps 1 and 2 until all the desired outcome is achieved.

Here is a sample “Asset” window after the tweaks.



How to Save Window as a Profile:


1. If the Profile window is minimised, Click “<<” button found at the upper right corner of the “Assets” window. Otherwise, proceed to Step 2.



2. Click “...” button and select “Create New Filter Profile...” from the dropdown menu.




3. Fill out the “Description” box with a name for this profile. Example below: “RTU”




Then click “OK” to dismiss window.

- Click “Ok” again to dismiss the “Filter Profile List” window.



- Click “OK” on the confirmation message.



- Profile is now saved with all the Asset fields selected from previous procedures.

Remarks:
